

## Internet Use Policy

As part of the Moultonborough Public Library's commitment to meet the cultural, informational and educational needs of the community, the library is pleased to offer public access to the Internet.

All patrons of the Moultonborough Public Library are welcome to use our computers.

Not all sites on the Internet provide *accurate, complete or current information*. The Moultonborough Public Library has no control over the materials to be found on the Internet. The library does not condone the use of offensive material. The Internet user must evaluate the validity and accuracy of the information found. Some Internet sites are unavailable because of limited access.

User's must read our Internet Computer Use Policy and sign an "Internet Use Registration Form" and obey all copyright laws.

Parents are responsible for children's access to the Internet. Parents must sign "Internet Use Registration Form" for children under the age of 18.

An adult must accompany children under the age of 7.

Use is subject to good behavior as determined by the library staff.

Manipulation of any library operating systems, setups, or files is not allowed. Abuse of the equipment or the service will result in the user being denied further access to the system. Patrons will be held responsible for any damage to the equipment caused by misuse.

Computer use is for ½ hour at a time. If no one else is waiting you may continue to use the computer.

Users may not add to the computer's hard drive.

Printing on the laser printer costs 15 cents per page.

The staff will provide *limited* help and advice, as we are able.

Computers will be shut off 10 minutes before the library closes.
