Need Multiple Copies?

Local book groups may request multiple copies of books if:

- The books are not current popular titles
- The books are AT LEAST 6 months old
- There are enough copies available to borrow from other NH libraries.



How to Make a Request

One person from the group can contact the library to request we borrow multiple copies. Be sure to submit your request with as much notice as possible. At least six weeks ahead of the group meeting is suggested. It's recommended to give an alternate title choice in case we are unable to fill the first request.

Information required:

- Title and Author of the book
- Number of copies needed
- Special format requests (large print, audio CDs)
- Pick-up date
- Date books will be returned to the library



Join a Library Book Group

Second Tuesday of the month at 9:30 am Informal group that meets to discuss books people are reading.

Friends Literature Discussion

Takes place throughout the year and features discussions led by scholars.

Takes place throughout the year and is in cooperation with Granite VNA.

READS-to-GO

These book discussion kits are managed by the NH Library Association and are available for borrowing through Moultonborough Library. If the kit isn't available you can still request the title - we may still be able to get multiple copies through interlibrary loan. readstogo.libcal.com
