## \*PAPER LOG:

Pick up a paper log at the library. Record the time or books starting July 1 through August 14. Read to earn books, beads, dog tags and snacks. The more you read, the more you add to your chain or snack pack. If you attend an event, you will also earn extra beads or raffle tickets! Record your summer reading on the dinosaur game board(ages 0-5) or flower coloring page (ages 6+)for every 20 minutes you read on your paper log.

Turn in the completed log to the library and pick up a new one if time allows! All logs must be returned by Friday, August 14.

<b>AGES 0-5 EARLY READERS</b>	This is a read to me program. You will log the number of minutes read by checking off a block on the dinosaur game board. You will earn stickers and books.
<b>AGES 6-11 READERS</b>	For every 60 minutes logged you will earn beads and dog tags.
<b>AGES 12-18 TEENS</b>	For every 60 minutes you read you will earn snacks or beads and dog tags, you choose one!



On August 19, at 6:00 pm, we will pull names for gift certificates to Innisfree Book Store for the different age groups . We will also serve ice cream to celebrate your hard work and to recognize our 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten participants!
